## Metropolitan Chicago Synod, ELCA 2019 Pre-election Canvass Results

The Pre-election Canvass Committee wants to thank everyone for the responses received during the Pre-election Canvass process.

### SUMMARY OF RESULTS

We received 73 total response (including one duplicate response) from voting members, and nine responses for questions to be submitted from synod members. There were 68 names submitted (excluding the duplicate) by voting members, and a combined submission of over 100 questions.
