October 2018 to June 2019

Step 1—S9.04.01

 Synod Council appoints a five-member Committee on Pre-Election Canvass.
The committee members are:

> Ms. Nan Dahlke Rev. Jason Glombicki Ms. Yvette NewberryWhite Rev. Linda Norman Mr. Charles Willett

- Committee must meet general eligibility requirements (50/50 male/female; 60/40 lay/clergy; 20% persons of color/language other)
- Clergy members of the committee are not eligible for nomination or election

Step 2—S9.04.01.b.1

- April 1, 2019—deadline to register for assembly to participate in canvas
- April 2, 2019—E-mail to registered voting members of the assembly canvas instrument and instructions for identifying one person and submitting a question for forum

Step 3—S9.04.01.b.2

 April 23, 2019—last day to mail identification instrument—all must be signed by a registered voting member of the assembly

Step 4—S9.04.01.b.3

- May 17, 2019
- Committee e-mails to registered voting members of the assembly:
 - report of canvass with biographies of top six names identified (after confirming that they are willing to serve if elected);
 - announcing date(s) and location(s) for forum(s) to meet the identified people

Step 5—S9.04.01.c

• May 23 through June 6 - Hold public forum(s) for identified people to be introduced, address, and respond to questions from voting members *and others in attendance*. The number of forums, locations, and times to be determined by Committee on Pre-Election Canvass.

As the process progresses, the synod office will continue to share information with the synod.
